ear Members and Friends of Immanuel Lutheran Church, Recently a small group of us met to review the Holy Week services. Those services are soon upon us. Organist and Choirmaster Zachary Schurman and I had been living with these liturgies for two months in advance. That is part of the joy of planning the liturgies. Before we even enter Lent, our hearts are racing ahead to Holy Week, picturing each service, working on the hymns and sacred music, and most moving of all, picturing our Lord and Savior Jesus as he moves through this most holy of weeks.

So, our little group met recently to make final decisions for this year's Holy Week. Our planning group consisted of Organist and Music Director Zac Schurman, Pastor Carol Fryer, Vicar Lara Bhasin, Congregation President David Kiehl, and me. We gathered around the conference table in the Martin Luther Room, with piles of current drafts of worship folders before us and our red pens to mark updates. It is careful work that needs to be done. Many details need to be tended to. It is background work we try to do well so that when you come to church, you can worship with quiet and undistracted minds.

But underlying the practical work of our worship committee is our sense of awe and gratitude for the *events* of Holy Week. These are the events that have changed the world. They have changed the world for the better!

- + Easter Sunday, 11 a.m., April 9, I preach
